21st Century Parks: 100 Years of Arts in the Parks by the National Parks Service and BAYCAT

From Albert Bierstadt's 1863 paintings of what would become Yosemite National Park, to Ai Wei's 2014 installations on Alcatraz, artists have had a role in both bringing awareness to the wealth of natural beauty across the country, to helping to interpret historical sites and their modern context. This 4-minute video was produced in 2016 for the NPS centennial, and looks at the role of artists in creating new park experiences that more welcoming, meaningful and relevant to a wider range of visitors.
