



## Summer Arts Young Program Grantees

Summer 2016 (FY16-17)

Alexander Valley Film Society	The Alexander Valley Jr. Film Society Documentary Filmmaking Workshop will offer a one-day event for Sonoma County middle school, high school, and undergraduate students followed by an opportunity to work on a documentary film in concert with the Cloverdale Chamber of Commerce.
Art Escape	Friday Night Teen Drop-In includes 7 free weekly art-making sessions for teenagers from 6 pm - 10pm during summer break, culminating in an exhibition of personal work plus the completion of a community art project.
Artstart	Two summer projects will offer art instruction for youth through new public art installations in South Santa Rosa neighborhoods: a new mural on the Newhall Bike Path and a graffiti abatement project in the Moorland neighborhood.
Children's Museum of Sonoma County	Summer Wonder Camps will ignite and engage children in creative expression of all kinds, as well as science and engineering; 12 campers each week over the summer.
Cinnabar Theater	Young Rep Summer Camp will offer performing arts camp for 105 youth, ages 6-18 in 2 sessions, culminating in live performance of a Broadway-style musical.
Healdsburg Center for the Arts	Three arts education projects will be offered: "Mosaics - Making Sense of the World Piece by Piece" will result in a permanent mosaic installation at Foss Cree Community Center; "Mask Making and Magical Animals of Mexico," an exploration of folk art themes and techniques; and "Clay & Cardboard: Intergalactic Spaceships" in which students will build 3D sculptural space vehicles.
Luther Burbank Center for the Arts	The Summer Arts Sessions for Youth (SASY) comprise two programs. The 2016 Mariachi Camps, a music "boot camp" to teach basic music skills, musicianship, and teamwork through the mariachi cultural tradition, will take place in Santa Rosa and Cloverdale. One City Arts, held in the Roseland area of Santa Rosa, is a three-week visual arts program empowering youth to embrace their creative potential and emotions through art.
Petaluma Arts Center	Petaluma Arts Center will offer Summer Arts Camp for Kids & Teens, 9 weeks of day camps/workshops; guided tours of PAC exhibitions; facilitated small group examinations of selected artwork; culminating exhibition of student work; focus on youth with limited arts experiences.
Roustabout Theater	Roustabout Theater will hold master classes. Super-Series! is a series of 4 master classes over three weeks for students featuring 4 world-class teachers in musical performance, pop performance, American songbook, and acting.

Santa Rosa Symphony	Three-week instrument training camp, the most comprehensive classical music camp of its kind in Sonoma County, gives 180 students the opportunity to study either in full days or in a la carte classes on the instrument of their choosing.
Sebastopol Center for the Arts	Summer Art Camp for Kids offers 4 summer arts camps, all- day Mon-Fri providing quality art experiences at an affordable price.
Sonoma Community Center	Clay Day Camp and Community Table exposes students to ancient traditions of clay while investigating the role of modern technology in handcrafted objects. A one-week day camp for 7-15 year olds.
Sonoma Valley Museum of Art	Young Artist & Writers Workshop (YAW) is an interdisciplinary, high energy, creative writing and visual arts workshop for 40 youth occurring in 2 sessions at the Sonoma Valley Museum of Art. In conjunction with the SVMA summer exhibition "Surf Craft," youth will craft model wood surfboards and also explore selected ocean adventure/surf writings by authors, and write stories inspired by those works and the imagined history of their boards.
The Imaginists	The Imaginists' ION Project Summer Apprenticeships is a program that provides high quality education/training in the theater arts, performance experience, and mentoring for Sonoma County high school juniors and seniors from low-income districts. Students apply and interview for a paid summer position, receive comprehensive theater training, rehearse, and perform alongside professional & emerging theater artists as part of the Imaginists' summer bilingual tour.
