



Summer Arts Youth Program Grantees

2018 (FY18-19)

6 th Street Playhouse	The School of Drama conducts two six-week camps for up to 70 students who receive training in acting, dance, and singing from Master Instructors. Each camp culminates with a demonstration of students' artistic growth in the performance of a fully-staged musical.
Art Escape	Art Escape conducts four week-long summer art camps for teens and youth. Topics for 2018 include Character Design, Asian-inspired Art, Textile Techniques & Soft Sculpture, and Mexican Food & Decor.
California Indian Museum and Cultural Center	As part of its Healing through Cultural Arts Wellness Workshop series for tribal fire survivors, CIMCC conducts a Media Arts Summer Camp to engage fire-affected Native youth through culturally-enriched digital video production activities. The youth help create a short video about Indigenous Fire Ecology, to be screened this fall.
Cazadero Performing Arts Camp	Cazadero Performing Arts Camp awards scholarships to Sonoma County residents to attend its summer sleep-away music camp in the redwoods of Western Sonoma County. In-residence music educators work closely with young musicians to develop creativity and musicianship.
Cinnabar Theater	Young Repertory Summer Camp provides Sonoma County youth with the opportunity to explore their creativity through musical theater, with each camp culminating in live performances of a Broadway-style musical at Cinnabar Theater for the public.
The Imaginists	The Summer Internship Program provides high quality education and training in the theater arts, performance experience, and mentoring for Sonoma County high school juniors and seniors. Summer interns take a devising and writing workshop and participate in the Imaginists' annual free, bilingual, bicycle-powered summer tour working alongside Imaginists' core company of professional actors.
Healdsburg Center for the Arts	The Healdsburg Center for the Arts offers nine weeks of interactive children's visual and performing summer art classes at various locations in Healdsburg. Classes include calligraphy, ceramics, mixed media, mosaics, musical theater, painting, drawing, photography, sumi-e, and sculpture, instructed by numerous professional artists.
Luther Burbank Center for the Arts	Summer Arts Sessions for Youth gives 168 youth free access to impactful learning in Mariachi and the visual arts. The program connects youth with peers, family, schools, and their cultural heritage during summer camps held in their neighborhoods.
Main Stage West	Summer Drama Camp explores musical theatre and culminates in a public performance of Disney's "The Aristocats KIDS." Students participate in daily classes focused on advanced skills in acting, dance, and music.

Museums of Sonoma County	Youth+Art is a summer visual arts youth program at the Art Museum of Sonoma County led by well-known artists. In collaboration with Artstart and CAP Sonoma this summer, resulting Youth+Art student works will be part of the annual Día de los Muertos exhibit.
Santa Rosa Symphony	Santa Rosa Symphony's Summer Music Academy brings together young musicians for three weeks of immersive instrument and performance training with accomplished professional musicians. The academy features musical workshops, specialty classes for experienced musicians, and imaginative courses on ensemble playing, composition, and conducting.
Sebastiani Theatre Foundation	Performing Arts Camp is an intensive two-week program culminating in a performance at the Sebastiani Theatre. This grant also supports an increase in the number of junior counselors and counselors in training to help expand the program.
Sebastopol Center for the Arts	This 5-week day camp is designed to expose young artists to as many art mediums as possible and provide students with a supportive environment to explore their creativity. With the guidance of professional artists, students and their peers develop their artistic skills in two different styles each week.
Sonoma Conservatory of Dance	Summer Dance Arts Camps provide an experience in movement and creative expression by combining dance styles (ballet, hip hop, West African, jazz dance, Appalachian clogging) with music, cultural history and crafts for true interdisciplinary learning for beginner-through-advanced students.
Sonoma Valley Museum of Art	Summer Studios is a two-week art camp that utilizes a dynamic, interdisciplinary approach to creative learning. The program activities provide an authentic studio art experience and will encourage youth to form connections between art, culture, and community through visual and literary arts.
Windsor Performing Arts Academy	During a three-week camp, students work on all production aspects to produce and perform a musical theater piece. In 2018, the students will create the sets, props, and costumes, as well as learn songs and dances to stage "Thoroughly Modern Millie."
