"What Happens When Parks and Artists Partner to Advance Equity"

In 2015, two communities were awarded ArtPlace America investment grants to change their approach to building and managing parks by incorporating artists into their planning processes. More than three years later, the results "illustrate how arts-based strategies can preserve, express and bestow cultural heritage and identity, encourage community co-creation and empowerment in planning and building capital

projects, and promote healthy youth development."

Read the entire article to find out how the collaborations impacted the health of Zuni Pueblo youth in New Mexico, and how formerly un-involved neighbors were engaged in a cultural asset-mapping project for the Fairmount Park Conservancy in Philadelphia.
