Due to the recent PG&E Public Safety Power Shutoffs (PSPS) and the Kincade Fire, we have re-activated a number of our emergency and recovery resources. They include:

### Arts Education Framework Planning Grants for Public Schools

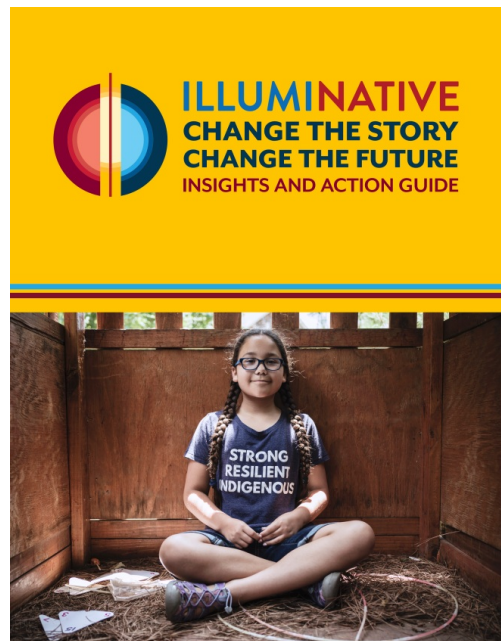

## CHANGING THE NARRATIVE: RECLAIMING NATIVE TRUTH

IlumiNative is a new initiative founded by Crystal Echo Hawk and a group of Native artists, thought leaders and allies, to capitalize on the findings of Reclaiming Native Truth (RNT) - the largest public opinion research and strategy setting initiative ever conducted for, and about, Native Americans. The data presented in RNT concluded that pop culture, media, and K-12 education drive and perpetuate negative stereotypes and myths and have led to the erasure of Native peoples. Initiative findings include statistics like "Only 0-.04% of primetime TV and films have a native character," and "27 states make no mention of a single Native American in K-12 curriculum."
