Announcing Creative Sonoma's new Director, Tara Thompson

Tara Thompson joined the Creative Sonoma staff as its new Director at the end of November 2023. Experienced in managing a broad range of arts programming and public art projects within local government, Tara most recently served as the City of Santa Rosa's Arts and Culture Manager.

In her role with the City of Santa Rosa, Tara is most proud of her work managing numerous and often complex and political public art projects, either with private developers on their percent-for-art requirements, or with numerous community stakeholders and neighborhood groups.

Tara shared that she "is grateful for the opportunity to continue serving the creative community and look forward to uplifting the excellent work of the Creative Sonoma Team," and that one of her goals is "to be particularly attentive to the emerging public art initiatives Creative Sonoma is supporting, including establishing a County public art plan and policy."

Tara received her Master of Fine Arts from Mills College and her Bachelors of Fine Arts from Sonoma State University. Prior to and integrated within her work for the City of Santa Rosa, she has worked in the arts field in educational, gallery and administrative positions. She lives in Santa Rosa with her husband Argo Thompson, CEO of the California Theatre of Santa Rosa, and their son Kai.

Sonoma County Arts Educator of the Year Award Recognizing Significant Contributions to Arts Education

This new award seeks to honor professional arts educators working with the K-12 population over an extended period of time including, but not limited to, arts and classroom teachers who teach visual art, music, drama, dance, or multimedia arts.

Candidates must meet one or more of the following criteria:

- Demonstrated Leadership
- Commitment to Equity
- Arts Education Champion
- Mentorship

The award recipient will receive a \$500 honoraria and a \$500 gift card to a local arts store of their choice for classroom supplies. This award is sponsored by the Daniels Chapel of Roses. Deadline for nominations is **January 12**, **2024**.
